THE ESTATE

Set in the very heart of the Beaujolais region, the estate is on the slopes of a named area called 'Saburin' at the foot of Mont Brouilly. The vineyards are on sandy granitic soils with an aspect that gives exceptional sun cover, making for wines with unique typicity.



His has been a vinegrower-winemaker family from father to son since 1855. Guillaume represents the 7th generation to steward the estate, which today covers 14 hectares (around 34.5 acres).

ENVIRONNEMENT

Work in the vines when the vineyards are on slopes remains more difficult and much of it (including each goblet-pruned vine) must be done by hand. The harvest is also 100% manual. Today, as each vineyard comes to the end of its life, Guillaume is replanting them to train the vines higher to make his work easier and to modernize.



KNOW-HOW

As far as vinification is concerned, the estate's aim is to continue to offer traditional wines with the aromas and flavours of the terroir they come from. This is why they are continuing to use ancestral methods (whole bunch picking, long vatting and maturing etc.) while adding some new techniques (temperature control, stainless steel vats etc.).
