Domaine BOULET has held true for 4 generations. From father to son, each in turn handing down his skills and knowhow.

The estate's main appellation is world renowned **Juliénas**.



David and Nadège took over this 12-hectare wine estate in 1993. Here, they have retained the techniques that were handed down to them by their forebears, as well as adding new technologies to their profession.

ENVIRONMENT

The estate uses an integrated, eco-friendly approach to vinegrowing and tend their vines in respect of both nature and the terroir in order to craft quality wines. Much of the vine work is done by hand, including pruning and picking. Most of the vines are around 50 years old.



KNOW-HOW

The vines give low yields of around 40 to 45hl per ha (up to 52hl per ha is authorised).

The Gamay grape variety and the advanced years of the vines, alongside the estate's know-how and skills, ensure that their wines are always of the highest quality.
