THE ESTATE

In 2021, the estate was taken over by two families with a passion for wine whose aim it was to perpetuate the work that had been done heretofore and with the ambition to go even further as far as quality in the vineyards and the cellar were concerned (converting to organic). They aso wanted to boost output, deciding to add brokerage and set out a 5 year plan to increase the surface area under vines.



TWO FAMILIES WITH A PASSION FOR VINES AND WINE

The estate spreads over around 24 hectares. All their vines are between 15 and 50 years old and grow in limestone-clay or clay soils, allowing the wines to give a mineral feel and freshness, especially for their Bourgogne appellation white.

ENWIRO NIMIENT

Wine quality comes first and foremost from the work invested in the vines. This is even more true for **organic wines**. The **value** of the grapes is to be the source of the end products' quality. The estate plans to move their entire production of red to organic within the next 5 years.



KNOW-HOW

The grape harvest spreads over a **fortnight**, generally between the end of August and the beginning of September.

Two thirds are picked by hand and a third by machine, always plot by plot to carry this through to the chai and vinify by terroir.
